ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must be six months of age or older and be registered with the American Kennel Club. Spayed and neutered dogs, dogs with Limited Registration, and dogs of an eligible breed that have been granted ILP/PAL are eligible to participate. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests: Dachshunds, Miniature Schnauzers, and the following Terriers: Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wirehaired), Glen of Imaal, Parson Russell, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Norfolk, Norwich, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh, and West Highland White, and Foundation stock Terriers: Cesky, Rat and Russell. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of The Dog Show Rules. Dogs may enter only one regular class at an Earthdog test, except dogs that have earned a Master earthdog title may enter more than one regular class. No further title certification will be awarded. Bitches in season shall not be allowed to enter the test and shall not be allowed within 100 feet of any testing area during the running of any class. Bitches in season are allowed at the general test site but should not be allowed to distract other dogs during the test hours. Entry fees for bitches in season will not be refunded.

Be sure to bring the information needed to complete the entry forms. A copy of the dog's registration certificate contains the necessary information.

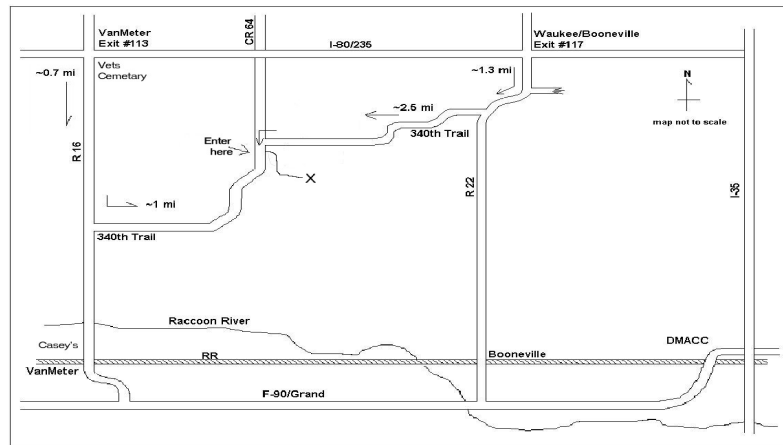

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

I-80 to Exit #117 (Waukee/Booneville- R22).
Go south 1.3 miles
Turn right onto 340th Trail
Continue west 2.5 miles on gravel road
Turn left (south) at stop sign
Turn left at next gravel driveway

OR

I-80 to Exit #113 (Van Meter- R16).
Go south 0.7 miles
Turn left onto 340th Trail
Continue east about 1 mile
Near top of hill turn right into gravel driveway



- * Coffee and donuts will be available the mornings of the tests.
- * Lunch and beverages will be available at the grounds both days.
- * There are no electrical hookups at the test site. There is no camping and/or overnight parking at the test site.
- * This is a private residence. We appreciate your help in keeping the grounds clean.

SHOW REGULATIONS

Declinations of Entries: Central Iowa Dachshund Club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Central Iowa Dachshund Club or any official thereof.

Bitches in Season Are Not Permitted in Test. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season will not be refund.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Judges Are Not Required to Wait for Dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when its class is to be judged. The show-giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the judging area when required.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this event.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Test Committee, be asked to leave the test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No loose dogs allowed on the grounds outside the judging areas.
- **No flexi leads.**
- Dogs are not permitted to wear collars during judging. Be advised that the judging areas will be only partially fenced.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- Please bring weather appropriate gear. Tests run rain or shine.
- ALL DOGS MUST HAVE CURRENT VACCINATIONS.
- Please keep the test grounds and buildings clean. THIS IS A PRIVATE RESIDENCE THAT WE ARE PRIVILEGED TO USE. PLEASE DISPOSE OF ALL WASTE AND CIGARETTES IN DESIGNATED CONTAINERS.
