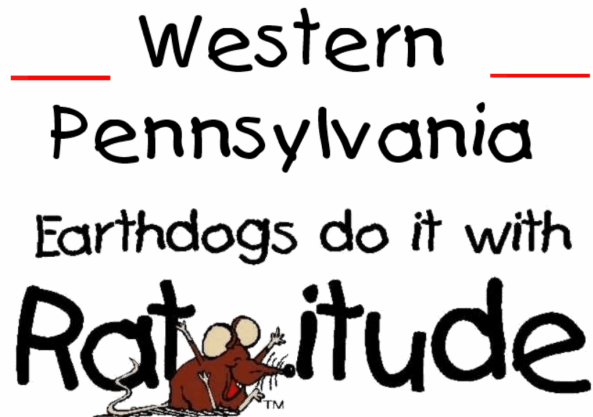

- Possessing or training with personal live quarry is not permitted on the show grounds at any time. Practice Sessions will only be permitted under the supervision of a Test Committee member.

## AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB CERTIFICATION

### ELIGIBILITY

- Dogs must be six months of age or older and registered with the AKC. Spayed or neutered dogs, dogs with limited registration and dogs with an ILP are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in Earthdog tests: Dachshunds and the following Terrier breeds; Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wire), Glen of Imaal, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Schnauzer, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Sealyham, Scottish, Silky, Skye, Welsh and West Highland White.
- In as much as Dachshunds and Terriers are hunting dogs, dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible. Dogs that are blind and/or deaf shall not be eligible.
- Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will not be refunded, unless the Test Secretary is notified before entries close.
- Master Earthdog is open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior Earthdog title before entries close or awarded the Master Earthdog Title.
- Senior Earthdog is open only to dogs that have acquired the Master or Junior Earthdog title before entries close.
- Junior Earthdog class is open to all eligible breeds of dogs that have not been recorded as or received qualifying scores in Senior Earthdog or Master Earthdog. Except that dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog title may enter Junior Earthdog Class.
- Dogs may enter only one regular class at an Earthdog Test; except dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog title may more than one regular class. (Regular classes are Junior, Senior or Master). No further title certificates will be awarded.
- Introduction to Quarry is not a prerequisite for Junior Earthdog; Introduction to Quarry is designed for the novice dog. Dogs may enter Introduction to Quarry and Junior Earthdog on the same day. Dogs entered in Senior or Master classes will not be permitted to enter Introduction to Quarry.
- The Endurance Earthdog (EE) title is earned when a dog, on five occasions, passes both the Senior and Master classes at the same event (one event number).

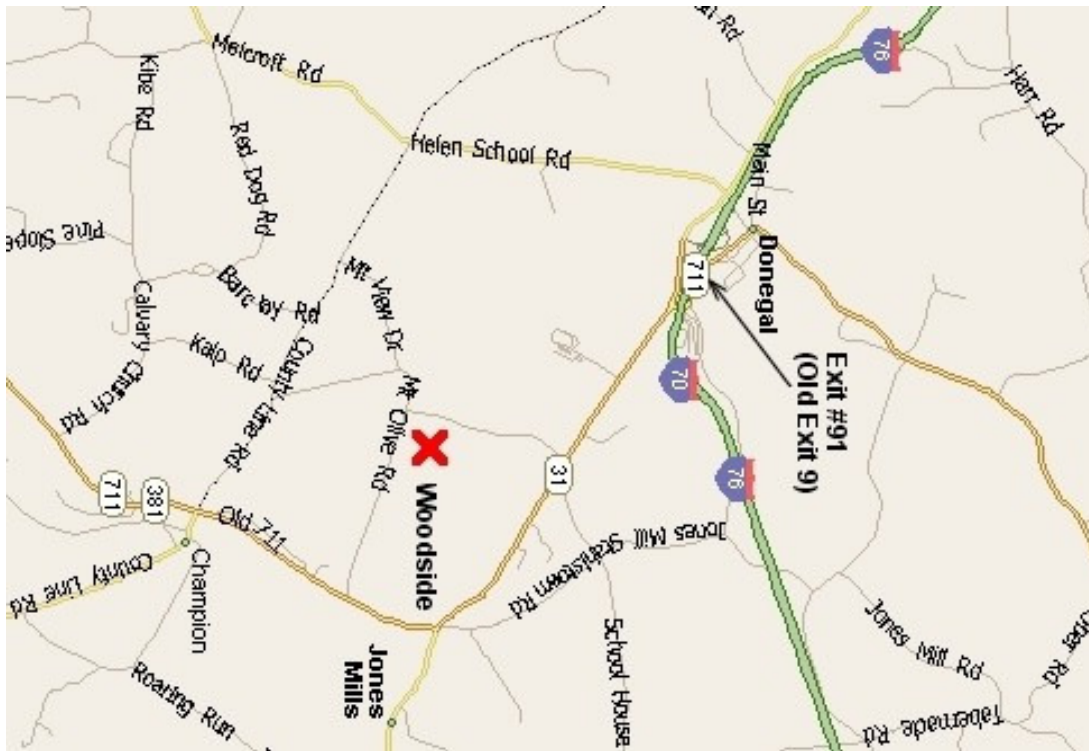

### - Directions -

#### **Directions from the West:**

Take the PA Turnpike to Exit #91 (old exit#9), Donegal. Turn left at the exit onto Rt. 31 East for approximately 1 mile. Look for the Prudential Realty sign on the right, make a right onto Mountain View Road. Go to the T intersection. Turn left onto Mt. Olive Road. As you start down the hill, test site is on the left. Turn into the gravel driveway by the barn with the red roof.

Park in the field that is uphill and left of the driveway.

#### **Directions from the East:**

Take the PA Turnpike to Exit # 110 (old exit #10), Somerset. Go to the second light and turn right (Harley Davidson) onto Rt. 601. Go to top of hill and turn right onto Main St - Rt. 31. Follow Rt. 31 for approximately 17 miles, after passing flashing light look for the American Legion and Prudential Realty sign on the left at the top of the hill. Turn left onto Mountain View Road. Go to the T intersection. Turn left onto Mt. Olive Rd. As you start down the hill, test site is on the left. Turn into the gravel driveway by the barn with the red roof.

Park in the field that is uphill and left of the driveway.
